Village History

White and Black Notley formerly constituted only one township. The name is supposed to have been derived from the Saxon *knut* and *ley*, a nut pasture and is mentioned in the Doomesday Book.

In Edward The Confessor's reign Notley was in the possession of Harold; a freeman, named Achi; Alestan, another freeman; Esgar; Levecild; and the Bishop of London. Very soon after, the whole was divided between

Geoffrey de Mandeville, Earl of Essex, and Roger Bigod, Earl of Norfolk; and without doubt these capital proprietors founded the churches of White and Black Notley upon their respective lands for the convenience of their tenants. The Parish of White Notley was held at the time of the survey by the Earl of Boulogne, Suene of Essex and Hamo Dapifer. It joins to the north side of Fairstead and lies 3 miles east from Black Notley. A strong loam on a clay bottom is a

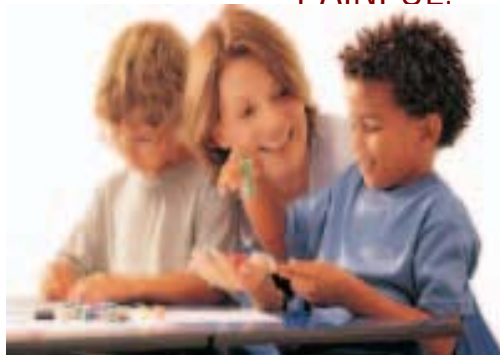

general character of the land.

In 1211 the Eugaine family held this manor, and retained possession till 1399, when it went to the family of Pakenham; and successfully passed into the families of Aylesbury, Cheney, Vaux, and the Wrights of Kelvedon Hatch.

White Notley Hall was occupied for a considerable time by a family by the name of Whitbread, they inter-married with the Smyths of Cressing.

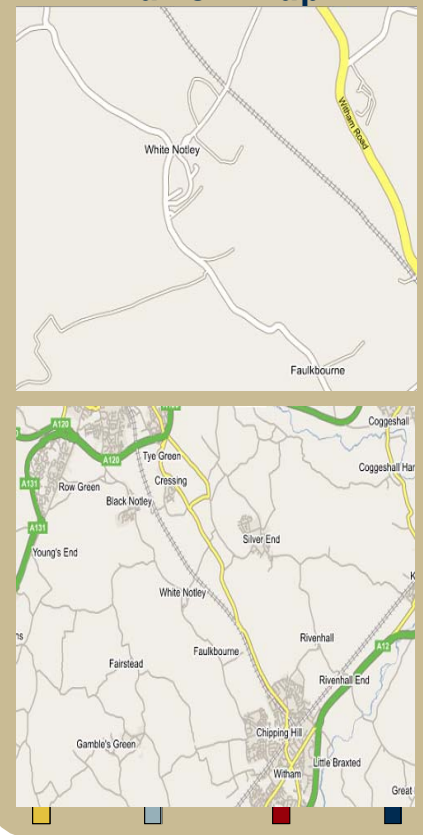

St Etheldreda's Parish Church

St. Etheldreda's Church is a historic Grade 1 listed building with many interesting features including the **oldest stain glass window in Essex** and wall paintings. It was mentioned as a place of worship in a will dated 1198.

The present incumbent is the Rev. John Hall, who is rector for 4 parishes; Terling, Fairstead, Faulkbourne as well as White Notley.
